- **Rockpool Rambles**

Safely discover some of the secret inhabitants of our ocean rockpools. Hold a crab, pat a seastar & find a barnacle... Wear shoes you can get wet, no thongs!

- **Junior Ranger**

Become a Junior Ranger! Learn about the local forests and discover the diversity and adaptations of native Australian wildlife through some fun activities.

- **The Beach @ Night**
