

ACTIVITY DESCRIPTIONS

The following activities involve a specialized tour inside the Split Point Lighthouse:

- **Twisted Tour**

A special kids tour for *Round the Twist* fans with fun and games in the famous lighthouse!

- **Wonderful Whales Tour**

Bring your binoculars (or use ours) for a special kids tour focusing on wonderful whales!

*Regular Lighthouse Tours also run daily at
11am, 12pm, 1pm & 2pm*

The following activities do not include a lighthouse tour:

- **Kite Making**

Make your own kite and test it out at the beach. We'll also be finding out about some special birds that fly for miles to come and rest or nest on our beaches. All equipment supplied

- **Rockpool Ramble**

Safely discover some of the secret inhabitants of our ocean rockpools. Hold a crab, pat a seastar & find a barnacle... Wear shoes you can get wet, no thongs

- **Winter Walks**

Rain or shine we'll be getting outside and exploring a local walking track. Be a 'bush detective' and look for signs and traces left behind by our native animals. Easy, 2 hour walks for average fitness and children aged over 7yrs.

- **Astronomy Night**

Bring your binoculars or use ours, for a closer look at the night sky! Identify stars and planets, and spot Saturn's rings. BYO rugs and beanies to fight off the winter chill!

- **Canoe Discovery Paddle**

Learn some basic skills, and join us on a canoe journey to discover more about the Coogoorah Park wetland and the animals that call it home. Children must be over 7yrs.

- **Winter Planting**

We all love to visit the beach, and these holidays we invite you to help us plant some native plants to protect this special environment. All equipment supplied, sponsored by GORCC.

Please wear comfortable footwear on activities and be prepared for the chance of a sunny day or cold weather!
